Criteria for awarding non-racing sailing trophies.

Notes

- The person nominated must be a current member of the LBYC.
- If a nomination is not made, the majority of the sailing committee may decide either to award a trophy to someone it considers meets the criteria or may decide that the trophy will not be awarded that year. If there is a perceived or actual conflict of interest a committee member must abstain from the discussion and voting.
- Nomination forms for trophies will be available on the club's website and at the bar at least two weeks before prize giving.

Russell Bates Memorial Trophy awarded for an older active sailor

- Awarded to an individual who has the gold card and who actively takes part in racing and/or cruising

Coopers and Lybrand Cup for the crew person of the year

- Awarded to an individual who can be relied on to take an active part in racing and/or cruising and/or boat maintenance

Walker Offshore Challenge Award

- Awarded to the skipper and/or crew of the boat that made an exceptional offshore voyage either as a race participant or as a cruiser.
- 'Offshore' in this context excludes Wellington Harbour, Cook Strait or the inner and outer Marlborough Sounds.
